On February 4, 2017, NEPACMS held its first workshop open to students all over Northeastern Pennsylvania. Violinist Daniel Andai, concertmaster of the Miami Symphony Orchestra and artistic director of the Killington Music Festival, led a riveting masterclass to two string quartets, both made up of university music-major students, a violin/viola trio, and a violin duo. The chamber orchestra consisted of 16 participants who had shown amazing progress in the short time that they had rehearsing with Dr. Andai. The evening concert was a culmination of the masterclass and rehearsal, and was very well-received by parents and community members alike.

Pre-Concert Lecture

On September 30, 2017, NEPACMS held its first pre-concert lecture before the *Colorful Clarinet Quintets* concert. Dr. Jennie Congleton generously gave her time and expertise to talk about the pieces to be performed in the concert and to our delight, many showed up to attend this lecture.

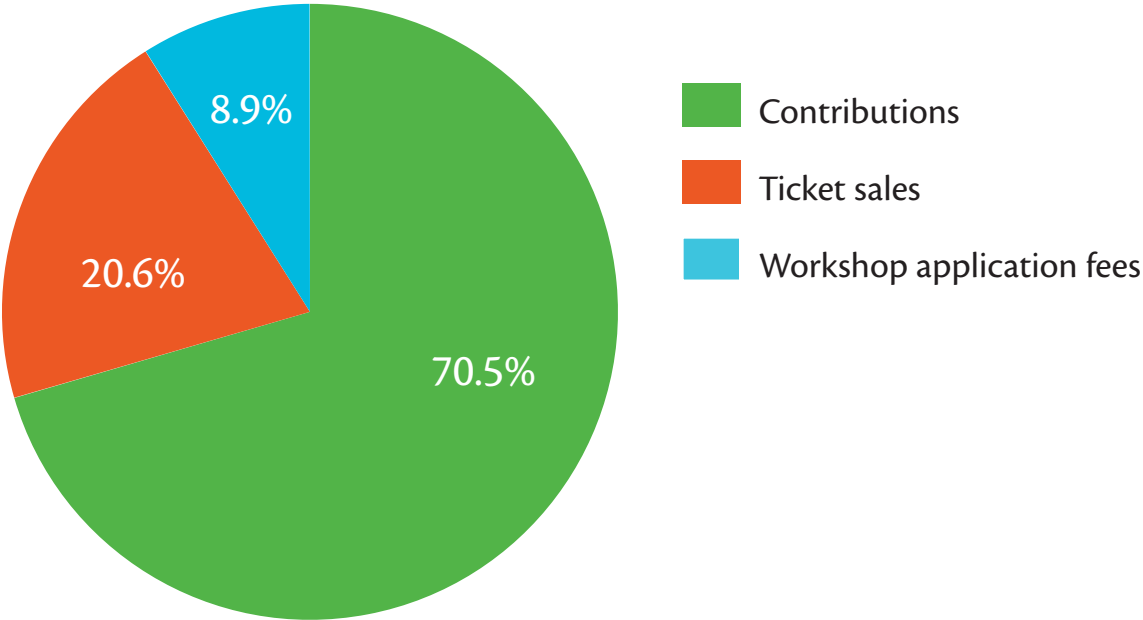

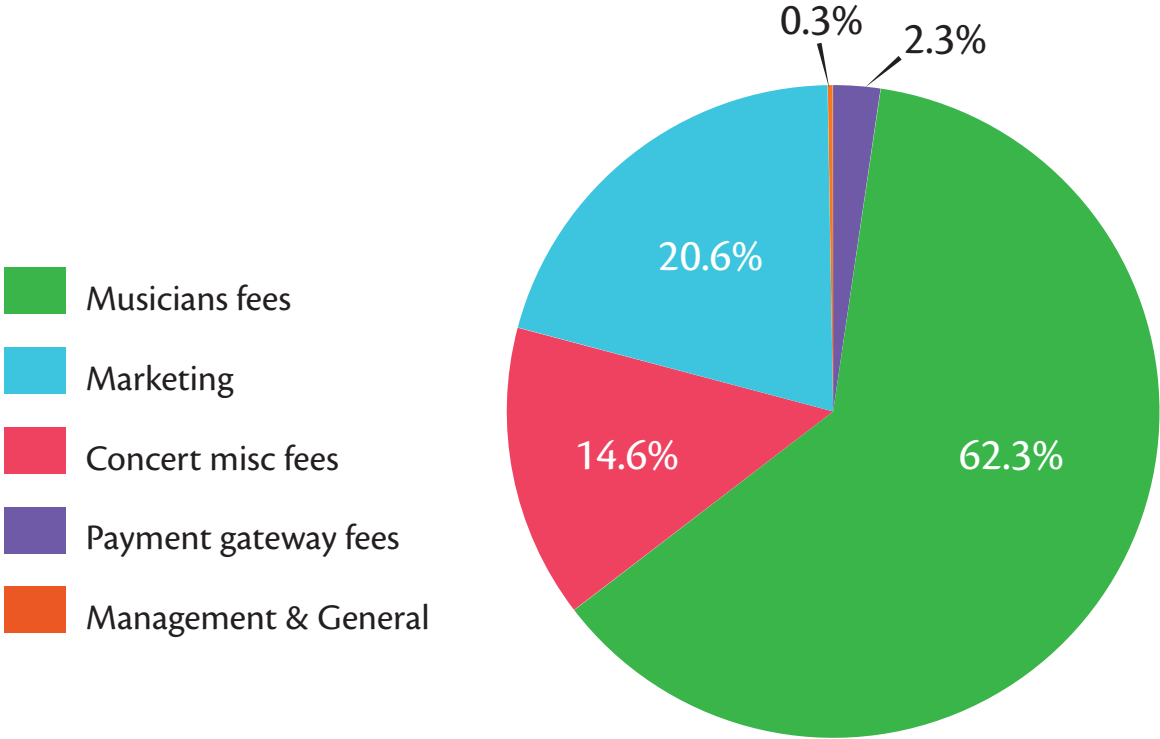
